# Competence

You must meet the following eligibility requirements to be admitted to the program.

### Knowledge in Swedish (Basic eligibility)

Suppose you have a mother tongue other than Swedish, Danish, Faroese, Icelandic, or Norwegian. In that case, you must have knowledge of Swedish, which is necessary for the Swedish National Agency for Higher Vocational Education (HVE) for you to pass the education.

(Although, for us, "knowledge of Swedish" means saying Hi, Thank you, and Bye, which is Hej, Tack, and Hej då. So, we'll give you that one)

#### Secondary education (Basic eligibility)

PlaygroundSquad's programs are all post-secondary education.

You have basic eligibility to be admitted to the program if you fulfill any of the following:

- You have completed a high school diploma in upper secondary school or municipal adult education.
- You have received the final grade from a fully national or specially designed program in upper secondary school and have the lowest grade Passed in at least 2 250 high school credits.
- You have received the final grade from upper secondary adult education and have the lowest grade Passed in at least 2 250 high school credits.
- You have a Swedish or foreign education corresponding to any of the above.
- You are a Denmark, Finland, Iceland, or Norway resident and are eligible for the corresponding education.
- Through Swedish or foreign education, you have practical experience or, because of any other circumstance, the conditions to qualify for the education.

### English 6 (Special Knowledge for all courses)

Has the lowest grade E / 3 / G in English 6 (100p) or equivalent.

#### Mathematics 3c (Special Knowledge for Game Programmer)

Has the lowest grade E / 3 / G in Mathematics 3c (100p) or equivalent knowledge.

#### Programming 1 (Special Knowledge for Game Programmer)

Have the lowest grade E / 3 / G in Programming 1 (100p) or equivalent knowledge.

### Art (Special Knowledge for Game Artist)

Have the lowest grade E / 3 / G in Art (100p) or equivalent knowledge.

# Real competence

For those who do not meet the basic eligibility requirements (grades), there is still an opportunity to be accepted. In some cases, we can make exceptions if we believe that you have so-called real competence, i.e., that you will be able to pass the education and work within the profession the training leads to. You may need to provide additional application documents if you rely on practical skills.

# Selection

*If there are more qualified applicants than places, a selection is made among the qualified applicants.* 

A selection is made in several steps to determine which applicants are admitted to the program. In the first stage, we make a selection based primarily on work samples to determine which applicants should be called for an interview. If you are called for an interview, then a second selection will be made based on your interview, your grades, and a practical assignment that is performed during the interview process.
